Healthy lifestyles enhanced through...

- Nearly 290 acres of park space with over 13km. of trails and pathways
- Ring Road approximately 4 km.
- Trail around Don Sparrow Lake - .9 km.
- Trail from High School parking lot to loop - .4km.
- Approximately 2,500 trees planted in various parks
- A total of 20 neighborhood parks offer both passive and active recreation opportunities
- Sidewalks along the roadways form part of the pedestrian walkway systems

Outdoor Summer Activities:

- 12 ball diamonds, 14 soccer pitches, 4 tennis courts, 4 outdoor basketball courts, 1 sand volleyball court, 2 football fields
- 18-hole golf course and driving range
- Inline hockey at Parc Reservoir Park

Outdoor Winter Activities:

- Skating at Beau Meadow and Bellevue school rinks, Don Sparrow Lake, Parc Nature Park 56A St. and 58 Ave., Millieu Park, Vallée Fields and Parc St. Vital Park

- Snow shoeing and cross country skiing at Parc Quatre Saisons/Four Seasons Park
- Ice fishing on Don Sparrow Lake
