

The Leaders in Training program is created for youth 12-16 years old who are wanting to develop their leadership skills. LIT is a well-constructed program, offering many different modalities for growth opportunities.

Applicants will have to go through an interview process in order to be accepted into this program, as there is limited availability.

If a candidate is successful for this program, the Leaders in Training program is available during the City of Beaumont's Summer Camps season of July and August. Applicants will have a few options of camps to choose from, and must commit to minimum 1 complete week of camp. The program will include one full camp of 30 hours, with an additional 5 hours of training time, resulting in a total of 35 hours.

Learning Module:

- Administrative practice – participant will be in charge of tracking attendance between every activity throughout an entire day
- Planning – participant will be in charge of planning one activity
- Leadership – Participant will lead planned activity
- Evaluations – participant will engage in both a self-evaluation, as well as an evaluation with their supervisor

*Participants will receive a signed module sheet after the completion of each module, that they may add to their “working portfolio”

Participants will leave this course with:

- Course certificate
- Personalized reference letter
- Developed work-place skills
- Leadership confidence
- Evaluative and reflective abilities
- Interview experience
