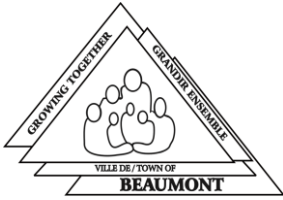

Financial Subsidy Program

The Town of Beaumont will subsidize, when possible, Beaumont Recreation and Culture program fees, for individuals and families who demonstrate an inability to pay for programs that would contribute to their personal growth and community involvement.

To qualify for program subsidy, families must meet the criteria by income. Refer to the table below:

FAMILY TYPE	MAXIMUM QUALIFYING INCOME
Single	\$29,073
Single parent with 1 or 2 children	\$29,073
Single parent with 3 children	\$34,056
Single parent with 4 children*	\$39,336
Couple with max. 1 child	\$29,073
Couple with 2 children	\$34,346
Couple with 3 children	\$38,997
Couple with 4 children*	\$44,000
* For each additional child add \$4,663	

- Financial assistance may be provided for a maximum of \$150.00 per person per calendar year (January 1 – December 31).
- Applicant must complete the request for subsidy application form.
- If applicant does not attend the registered course or program, future applications for assistance may be affected.
- Applicant must apply annually for subsidy.
- Funds are on a first come first served basis depending on allocated yearly budget.
- Funds must be used in the calendar year in which they were received.
- The decision of the Town of Beaumont is final.
