
A Brief Overview of By-Law Information in Beaumont

1. **DOG CONTROL:**

All dogs over the age of six months must be licensed. License fees are due by January 31 of each license year. New dogs or dogs reaching the age of six months must be licensed within one month. Dogs are not permitted to run at large in Beaumont, nor bark or howl excessively.

2. **CAT CONTROL:**

All cats over the age of six months must be licensed. License fees are due by January 31 of each license year. New cats or cats reaching the age of six months must be licensed within one month. Cats are not permitted to run at large in Beaumont.

3. **BUSINESS LICENSES:**

Every person operating a business within or partly within the Town of Beaumont requires a Beaumont business license. This license requirement also applies to home occupations. In addition, all home occupations require a Development Permit.

4. **DEVELOPMENT PERMITS:**

A development permit and/or building permit is required for most improvement projects including deck construction, garage construction, basement development and fireplace/wood stove installations. Permits ensure that the project complies with safety codes and meets established standards.

5. **SNOWMOBILES & TRAIL BIKES:**

The operation of all off-highway vehicles on other than your own property is prohibited within the corporate limits of the Town.

6. **SNOW REMOVAL:**

Residents of Beaumont are required to remove snow from sidewalks fronting and flanking their properties within forty-eight hours after a snowfall. All residents are prohibited from dumping snow taken from their property, (driveways, etc.) onto Town sidewalks and roads.

7. **WASTE COLLECTION:**

Refuse should be placed at the collection point the night prior to collection day, but should not be there sooner than 24 hours before collection. Download the Keep It Green Beaumont App and find more information at: <http://www.beaumont.ab.ca/curbside>.

8. **WRECKED VEHICLES:**

Storage of wrecked or dismantled automobiles in residential zoning is not permitted. There are many auto wreckers who will haul these vehicles away free of charge.

9. **PERMITS & LICENSES:**

The permits, registration and licenses previously described may be obtained from the Town of Beaumont Administration Office at 5600- 49 Street (929-8782). Office hours are from 8:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m., Monday thru Friday.
