**A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF BEAUMONT IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO AMEND
LAND USE BYLAW 944-19**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 639 and 640 of the *Municipal Government Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c. M-26, and amendments thereto, the City of Beaumont has adopted Land Use Bylaw 944-19;

AND WHEREAS, the Council deems it desirable to amend Land Use Bylaw 944-19;

THEREFORE, pursuant to the *Municipal Government Act*, the Council of the City of Beaumont, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

That the Land Use Bylaw 944-19 of the City of Beaumont be amended as follows:

1. Section 4.4.4. under "Signs Not Requiring A Development Permit" is amended to be read as follows:
 - Election signs means federal, provincial, municipal, and/or school board election signs as may be regulated by the *Elections Canada Act* or *Local Authorities Election Act*, and the placement of election signs shall be permitted in the Municipality without a development permit and must comply with the guidelines for election signs prescribed by council policy.
