TRAFFIC SAFETY BYLAW AMENDMENT

**A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF BEAUMONT IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA AMENDING
TRAFFIC SAFETY BYLAW 834-14.**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 7 and 8 of the *Municipal Government Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c. M-26, and amendments thereto, Council may pass by bylaw; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 191 of the *Municipal Government Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c. M-26, and amendments thereto, Council may amend a bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the *Municipal Government Act*, the Council of the City of Beaumont, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

That the Traffic Safety Bylaw 834-14 of the City of Beaumont be amended as follows:

1. Under "Section 10: Miscellaneous" the following sub-sections are added:
 - 10.09 No Person shall place upon the publicly owned portions of a Highway, abutting a Roadway or upon any structure abutting a Highway, any sign, mark or notice relating to federal, provincial, municipal, and/or school board elections as regulated by the *Elections Canada Act* or *Local Authorities Election Act* unless all terms and conditions for the placement of such signs meet Province of Alberta Guidelines for Election Signage in Highway right-of-ways and/or Council Policy for Election Signs.
 - 10.10 For the purpose of Section 10.09, any individual or corporation referred to on a sign, whether directly or indirectly, is presumed to have placed the sign or caused or permitted the sign to be placed.

2. Within "Schedule A: OFFENCES AND PENALTIES," the following sub-section is added:
 - 10.09 Placing sign/mark or notice relating to an election in contravention of the guidelines for the placement of such signs prescribed through council policy - \$50.00.

READ A SECOND TIME IN COUNCIL THIS 24th DAY OF NOVEMBER, 2020.

READ A THIRD TIME IN COUNCIL THIS 8th DAY OF DECEMBER, 2020.
