Past Council Members Recognition of Service (1:50)

Mayor Bill Daneluik recognized the past mayor John Stewart and past councillors Perry Hendriks, Martin Stout for their service during the 2017-2021 council term.

Dansereau Meadows Redistricting (12:31)

Council approved a bylaw <u>amending a portion of the Dansereau Meadows neighbourhood</u> from Conventional Neighbourhood District to Integrated Neighbourhood District to allow for the development of urban townhomes.

Recreation, Parks and Culture Advisory Committee Report (26:31)

The Recreation, Parks and Culture Advisory Committee <u>provided a report to council</u> on its activities in 2021. The committee advises Council on the planning of a range of recreation, parks and culture programs and services in Beaumont.

Land Use Bylaw Report (33:42)

Council approved <u>a motion by Coun. René Tessier</u> directing administration to prepare a report on aspects of the City's Land Use Bylaw, including the feasibility and impact of additional parking restrictions and dwelling units on residential zones, and an overview of standards for home-based businesses. The motion directed administration to report back to council by the end of the second guarter of 2022.

Snowplow Naming Contest (1:16:57)

Council approved a motion by Mayor Bill Daneluik directing administration to prepare a report on options and feasibility of a contest for children to name the City of Beaumont's snowplows. The report is due back to council by the end of the first quarter of 2022.
