


Q1 Do you live in Beaumont?



Q2 Have you used an e-scooter before?



Q3 How often do you think you or a family member would use an e-scooter this year?



Q4 What is the likelihood that you or a family member would use an e-scooter in Beaumont this summer?



Q5 What would be the main reason for using an e-scooter? (select one)




