Key Responsibilities

- Assist staff with general event needs
- Answer guest questions and provide friendly on-the-go support
- Support performers with basic needs or directions
- Monitor activity in designated areas and reporting concerns
- Communicating with staff
- Keeping festival walkways and activity zones clean, welcoming and accessible
